- 1. What is the scene about? **TEXT**
- 2. What is the scene REALLY about? **SUBTEXT**
- 3. What is the **conflict** in the scene?
- 4. Describe **the dramatic arc** of the scene? From what to what?
- 5. Identify all the <u>beats</u> in the scene. Mark them on the text. Indicate who wins each beat (as each beat is a confrontation).
- 6. Is there a **shift of power** in the scene? Indicate the beat in which the shift of power takes place.

(A scene is a conflict between two characters [forces or ideas]. A shift of power is a change in the balance of power between the characters. Although both characters should be formidable, in the end one must prevail.)

CHARACTERS

- 1. Who is the main character? (his/her **back story**).
- 2. What does s/he want?
 - A) **Conscious goal** (what does she want?)
 - B) **Unconscious desire** (what does she REALLY want?)
- 3. What is his/her **character flaw**? How does it incite and drive the action of the scene?

The most conflicted part of her/his personality or aspect of her life; the biggest problem? Unresolved conflict? It drives all her actions. When and how did it start? Identify the events from the past.
